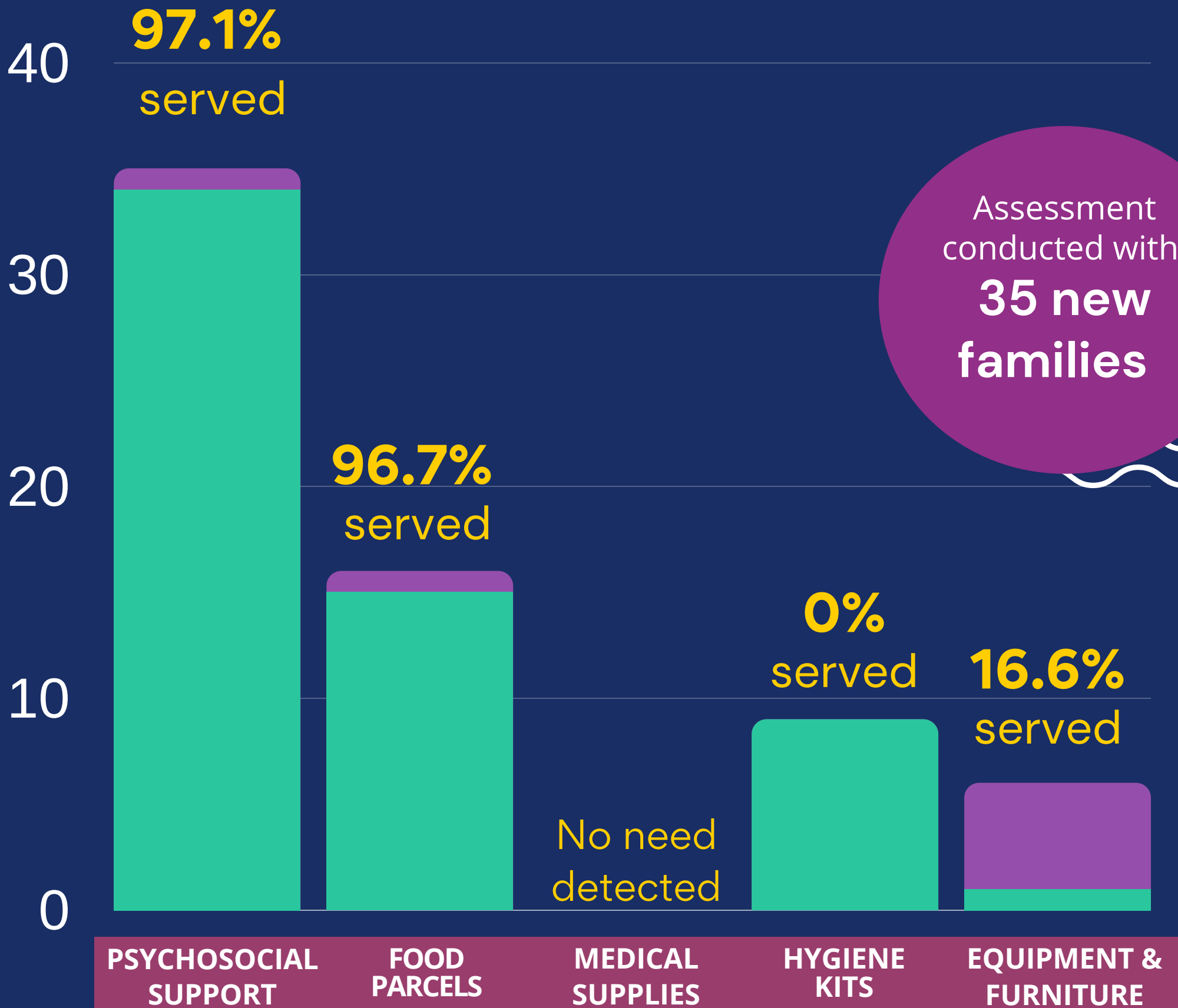

We were also able to reach **296** child and **12** caregivers affected by the blast, through our recreational activities and parenting sessions.

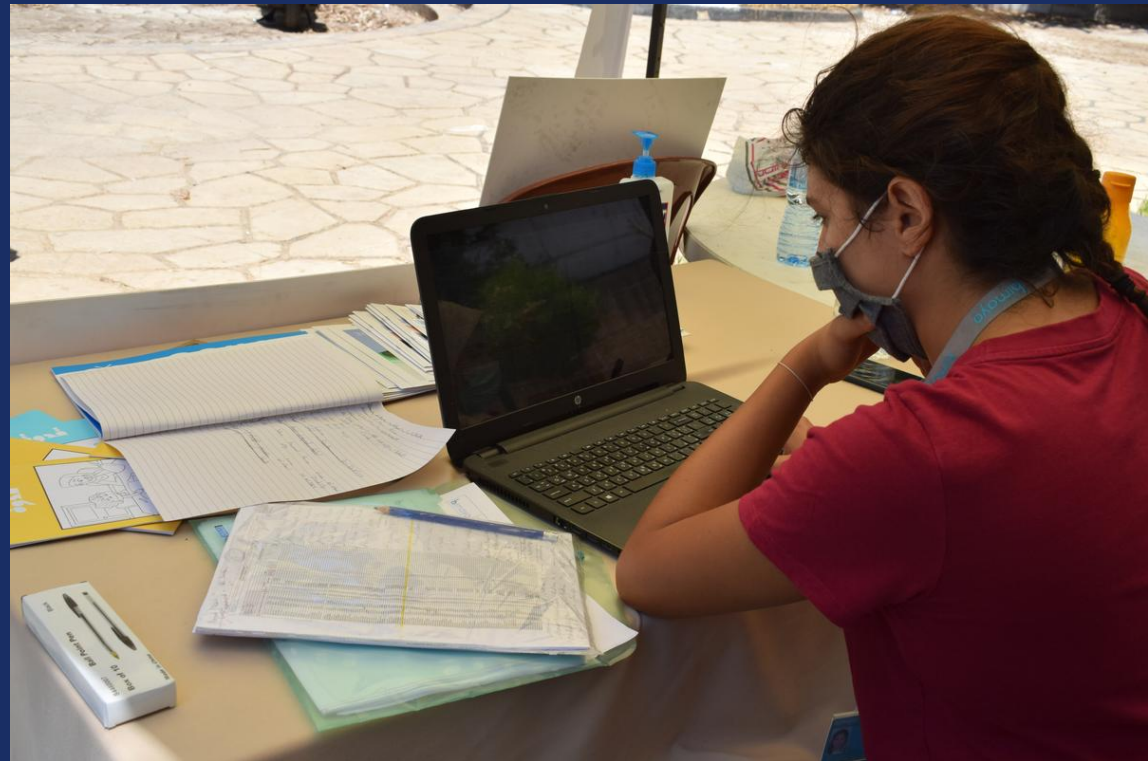


22 child also benefited from specialized group interventions (FPSS) through our on-ground presence in Geitawi

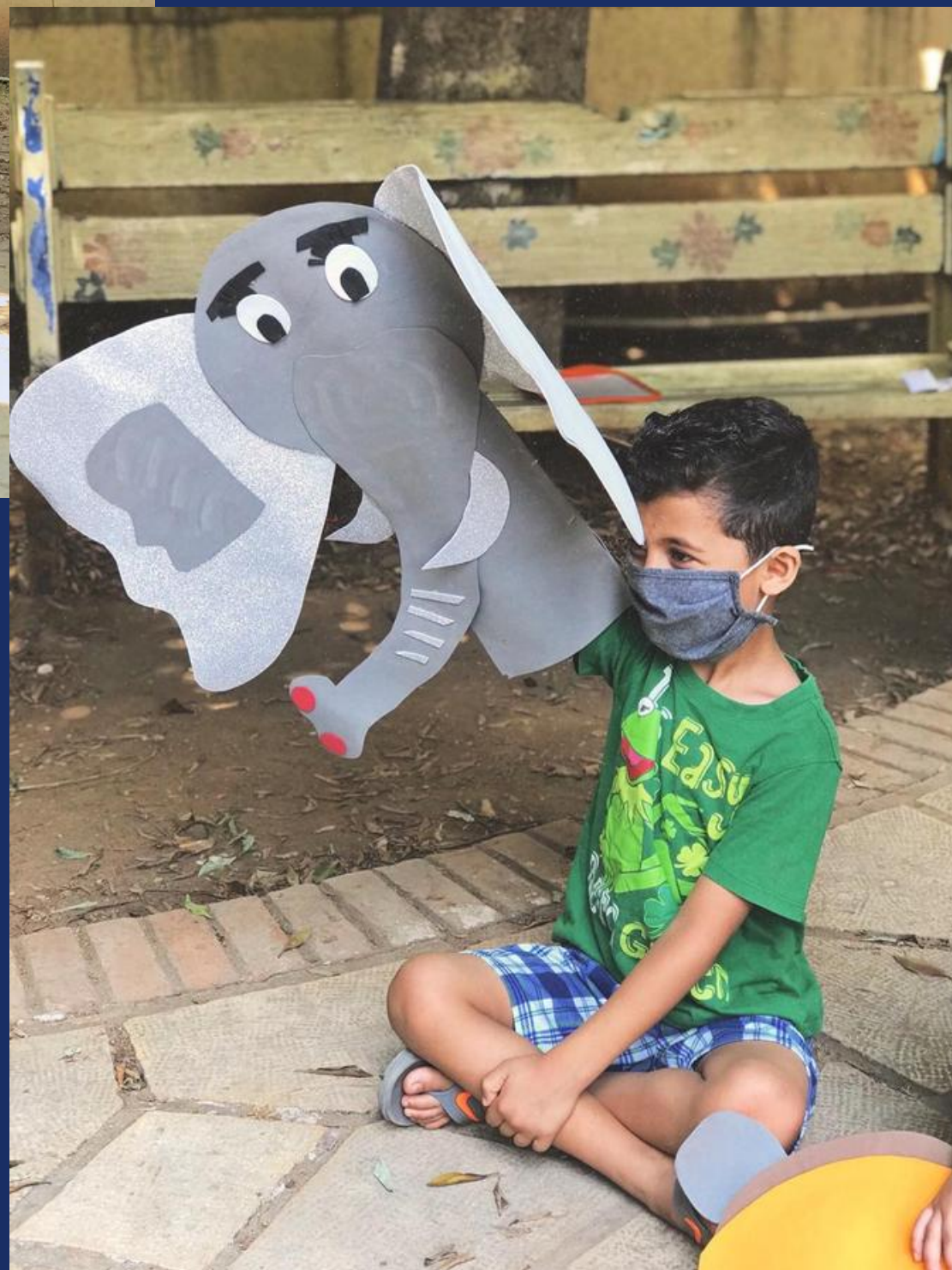


Children living in areas affected by the blast are attending our on-ground psychosocial support activities and learning about their rights in a fun and interactive way
